- 1. FFP Respirator Masks are only required if there is an Aerosol Generating Procedure (AGP) such as performing Neonatal Resuscitation or intubation for a general anaesthetics intubation for a general anaesthetic
- 2. Plastic aprons can be substituted up to full fluid resistant gown based on individualised risk assessment of the care episode
